- NHS advice is if you can't heat all the rooms you use, it's important to heat your living room during the day and the bedroom just before going to sleep to at least 18°C

- Register for priority services in case of interruptions like power cuts. Certain groups like older people or those with young children can register for priority with utility providers if we have power cuts or other interruptions.
